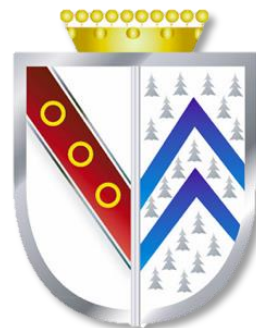

D – **Difference**

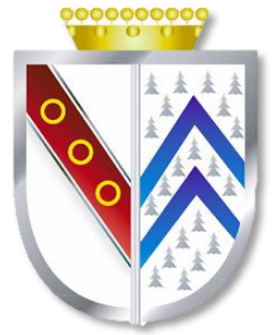
E – **Excellence**
