# Parent

Parent/Carer.....

## To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- Declare to the school office if a member of the household has travelled to a country with quarantine measure in place.*
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- When dropping my child off and picking them up adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.*
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- When dropping off, my child will remove any disposable face mask they are wearing, placing disposable ones in the bin/double bag a fabric one which I will take away with me.
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time.
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I will ensure the school has at least two emergency contact details and will inform the office of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.*
- I will follow social distancing rules at all times, and understand if there is evidence that I have not followed current government guidance, I can expect to be contacted by a member of school leadership team*
